



Preparing for your dog's overnight stay:

We understand it can be a big change for any dog to spend the night in a different environment and away from their family. We always recommend a new dog attend a couple of days at daycamp prior to an overnight stay. This will give your dog an opportunity to make friends with the Paws Chateau staff, meet new dogs and get familiar with the facility and the surroundings.

What to bring?

1. Bring vaccination records:

- Bordetella (paws Chateau requires this every 6 months)
- DHLPP (1yr or 3yrs)
- Rabies (1yr or 3yrs)

2. Food

Please bring your dog's food, labeled with the dog's name and appropriate serving size. Your dog can bring treats also, please ensure they are labeled with your dog's name and serving instructions.

You may choose "House Food" for an additional charge.

3. Medications

Please provide an adequate amount of medication, clearly labeled with the dog's name and instructions.

4. Bedding, Blankets & Belongings

Dogs can bring beds, blankets and even crates. We know that dogs feel calmer and more relaxed when they something from home. They can also bring a favorite toy. Please ensure your dog's name is on all their belongings. Paws Chateau cannot guarantee all belongings will be returned in the same state in which they were provided.
