



**What to expect with and following your dogs stay at Paws Chateau:**

- While your dog is staying with us, they may have up to 12 hours of play per day if they are approved to join the playgroup
  - This frequently results in dogs been very tired when they go home, especially is they have stayed at Paws Chateau for multiple days
  - Dogs that do not frequently spend several hours outside daily may have minor pad abrasions from their hours of play and activity. These frequently will resolve on their own and do not require any medical attention
  - Pets may be sore after their long days of play, especially if they are elderly or have a previously diagnosed lameness. If our staff notices a dog that may be tired, overwhelmed or showing signs of soreness we will remove them from the playgroup and return them to their suite for some rest time.
  - During your dog's interactions, there may be minor cuts and scrapes that will occur. If they require medical attention the staff at Paws Chateau will take the dog to our on call vet for treatment
  
- Many pets will not eat normally while away from their family
  - We notice that some dogs are less enthusiastic about their food while they are not in their normal environment. This is very common.
  - If your dog consistently does not want to eat, we may take some measures to entice your dogs to eat (example - broth, pumpkin, wet food). Please make sure the Paws Chateau staff know about any food allergies your dog may have.
  - We are very diligent about knowing each dogs eating habits and will provide feedback about their eating patterns during their stay.
  - If you bring your own food, you may have some food returned to you.
